

2024 School Planning

The purpose of this meeting is to:

How is Our School Development Plan Used?

- Guides ongoing assessment and review of goals and actions.
- Our school development plan is the driver for closing learning gaps and informs:
 - Instructional strategies
 - Professional learning
 - School structures and processes for learning
 - Resources to improve student learning
 - Data-informed decision making





School Development Plan – Overall Goal

Our focus at King George School for the 2023-2024 school year is improving assessment practices in all subject areas, and specifically creating a feedbackrich culture through cycles of learning. This will ground our work in the three areas of literacy, mathematics, and well-being.





School Development Plan – Literacy & Mathematics Improvement

- Students use success criteria to receive and give multiple rounds of feedback on their work with peers, from their teacher, and through self-reflection to improve their learning and determine next steps. Students will:
 - Use exemplars to co-create criteria with teacher
 - Use peer-/self-checklists, learning targets, rubrics to give and receive feedback
 - Receive explicit instruction and modelling of how to give and receiving peer feedback using success criteria
 - Receive time to give/receive multiple rounds of peer, self & teacher feedback to improve learning







School Development Plan – Well-Being Improvement

• If students understand what they are doing, the purpose for learning it, and how to be successful in meeting learning targets using success criteria, then students will be more connected to their learning and develop a deeper sense of belonging and confidence in their learning progression.

- Our school received \$3,963,810 in 2023-24 to provide a quality education to our students and meet the goals in our school development plan (SDP).
- At least 75 per cent of budgeted funds covers staffing and the remaining portion covers instructional and operational supplies.


