

The Secret Spaces of King George School

King George is a school that has a lot of history and comes from a community that, over 100 years, has survived many changes. Take a virtual tour of the “Secret Spaces of King George School” created for the centennial celebration in May 2013. Viewers will be treated to scenes of lesser known nooks in the school, including the boiler room where classes were once held; the attic, where there is still evidence of where J.J. Souter, who was principal from 1956 -1971 used to practice his golf skills; and an awe inspiring view of today’s downtown, as seen from the bell tower.
