Patrick's first year teaching at King George.  ■ Grade 4s will be visiting Heritage Park in early November. This field trip will complement the grade 4s learning in social studies - focusing on Indigenous learning and pioneers in Alberta.  ■ Grade 4s will visit the Science Centre on a second field trip in March.  ■ Thank you school council for covering field trip transportation/bussing!  Grade 1: Mme Peggy  ■ This is Mme Peggy's 8th year at King George, teaching grade 1.  ■ Currently, the grade 1s are working on:  □ Reading - focusing on letter sounds, recognition of uppercase and lowercase letters, and blending consonants and vowels  □ Writing - practicing letters, writing sentences, and composing sentences using sentence starters  □ Math - focusing on number sense, representing numbers 1-20, subitizing, beginning addition & subtraction, and patterns  □ Science - learning about seasonal changes in the fall and using the 5 senses  ■ The grade 1s will be participating in a Fall Walk through Confederation Park on Friday to observe autumnal changes in nature.  □ Social Studies - focusing on identity and family heritage  □ Indigenous Knowledge - learning about the medicine wheel, spirit animals, and discussions around residential schools  □ Wellness - incorporating the Mind-Up program (social emotional awareness and wellness) into daily routines  Grade 2 & Learning Leader: Mme Christina  ■ Mme Christina is leading Indigenous education at King George school through her Learning Leader role.  ■ Currently, the grade 2s are working on:  □ French Language Arts (FLA) - focusing on blending sounds,		

structured literacy, and oral language development (asking and answering questions) Writing - practicing sentence writing and using key words Math - reviewing numbers 1-100, working towards numbers 1-1000, focusing on patterns and measurement (incorporating the medicine wheel into measurement while learning about the passage of time) ■ The grade 2s will be working on a coding math unit led by students from the U of C. Social - reviewing communities, practicing mapping skills, and discussing the medicine wheel ■ The grade 2s will be participating in a field trip to Confluence (formerly Fort Calgary) to complement their learning in social studies. Science - focusing on material and their properties Mind-Up - starting and ending the school day with mindful breathing, practicing mindfulness after transitions throughout the day (i.e. after lunch, after recess, etc.), and practicing mindful actions with each other, the classroom, and the school The grade 2s have been focusing on one of the seven sacred teachings: Respect. They have been learning about the buffalo (representing respect) and relating this to how we respect each other, our community, and our planet. Closing Balance: \$20 978.90  2) Friends of King George School Account (Casino): Money in this account comes exclusively from casinos. The AGLC sets specific guidelines for how this money can be spent. Any money from this account must go directly toward student engagement.  Closing Balance: \$138 679.06

Sarah is waiting to hear back from a class that would be interested in doing this task.         <ul> <li>Are this year's grade fours interested in participating in the compost project again this spring?</li> </ul> </li> <li>ACTION: Allison will check with the grade 4 team to see if teachers are interested in participating in the compost project again this spring.</li> <li>West Coast Seeds fundraiser application has been submitted. We have requested earlier dates this year, so that seed orders will arrive before spring break. We are hoping to run this fundraiser January 8th-17th, 2025.</li> </ul>
8:11 PM Item 12 Transportation & Active Routes Update	Sarah A.	<ul> <li>Transportation &amp; Active Routes Update</li> <li>Currently working with the city to figure out the issues with our permit applications. We had applied for a street closure permit for the school streets project, however, all permits were denied.</li> <li>Please send any feedback about the school streets project via the survey link that was sent out last June (link can also be accessed from the school council linktree website). All feedback is appreciated!</li> <li>In attempts to move traffic away from the school, there has been discussion around making "walk maps" with each grade level. These maps would outline how far students can walk in 2 or 5 minutes. We are trying to encourage families to park a block or two away from the school and spend 5 minutes walking rather than 5 minutes sitting in the traffic congestion around the school. Some families are already doing this and it is greatly appreciated!</li> <li>Reminder that patrollers are out during drop off in the morning and pick-up in the afternoon. Their job is to help students cross the street safely, not control traffic flow. This may cause traffic delays, therefore, you may want to park further away.</li> </ul>

This is a great opportunity for everyone, as the cost is \$150 (compared to \$500 that has been paid in the past).</li> <li>We need insurance for the dance. For a commercial policy it will cost approximately \$750 for the entire year, or \$250-\$300 for the dance as a single event.</li> </ul>
